#### **ROUTINE VACCINATIONS**

Available for all, including:

- Infant immunizations
- Back to school immunizations
- Vaccines during pregnancy
- Senior vaccinations
- Seasonal vaccinations



### **VACCINES FOR CHILDREN PROGRAM (VFC)**

Children 18 years or younger who are uninsured may be eligible for all childhood and adolescent vaccines outlined necessary by the Advisory Committee on Immunization Practices at reduced cost



#### **INTERNATIONAL TRAVEL CLINIC**

Registered nurses offer travel consultations and travel immunizations. Topics discussed during consultation include:

- Possible health risks & personal protection measures
- Food & water safety tips
- High altitude sickness & motion sickness
- Traveling while pregnant
- Medication for travel related illness
